



#### **Pool Contstruction Progress**

The pool construction is progressing as planned. The building is 75% completed with the pool being gunited this week. As well as starting on Grade work, site utilities, and working to get power established with Oncor. We are anticipating the pool to be completed within 30-45 days and the HOA opening for residents to enjoy mid-July, weather permitting. We appreciate everyone's patience as we move toward completing this exciting amenity.

# Play Area Inspection & Mulch Refill

A recent inspection of the community play area has been completed. Necessary repairs and mulch refilling are scheduled over the next few weeks. Residents will be notified once dates are finalized.

## Pond & Greenbelt Water Flow Assessment

The City of Frisco's Storm Water Division has completed its inspection of the ponds and greenbelt areas. Preliminary feedback was provided on pond drainage, and we are continuing to work with the city for further recommendations on greenbelt management.

#### Reserve Account Setup

The HOA is in the final stages of selecting a new reserve account. The account is expected to be opened in June 2025, with initial deposits to follow soon after.

# Landscaping & Maintenance Vendor Optimization

After reviewing proposals from seven different vendors based on service quality, pricing, and overall value, we have made changes to improve landscaping services in Dove Creek.

We are pleased to announce All Seasons has been selected as our new landscaping vendor, replacing D&D. Their team has already started work and is demonstrating consistent, on-time service.

# Free Community Sprinkler System Check

The City of Frisco recently completed a free inspection of all sprinkler systems in Dove Creek's open/common areas. All Seasons has been assigned to perform the identified repairs and expected to be completed in he coming weeks.

#### Community Sign Board Repairs

The HOA team contacted the Frisco Public Works Department regarding damaged sign boards in the community. The affected boards have since been repaired and restored throughout the neighborhood.

#### Appreciation to Fellow Residents

- A big thank you to Gireesh, who proactively removed hazardous, overgrown trees near the community walking path and along the shared builder installed fence, improving safety for all. We encourage other residents to take similiar action when needed.
- Thank you also Hazarat for reporting a tree damaged by beavers near the pond on Single Leaf Dr. The HOA is now working with the City of Frisco to implement preventative wildlife solutions.

Frisco Police have noted chain-snatching incidents in nearby neighborhoods over the past few years. Please avoid wearing visible, high-value jewerly when walking, especially during early mornings or evenings.

Just a reminder: No resident-owned trees are being serviced without authorization. All current tree work is for HOA-managed common areas and is based on the community's approved landscaping plan. #### Seasonal Flowers at Entrance


We've added seasonal flowers at the Dove Creek entrance to enhance curb appeal and beautify our community's main entrance.

The mulch recently added around the community trees by D&D was included in the 2024 budget. After a consulation with an expert arborist recommendations were provided to extend mulch coverage around tree bases for better root health and water absorption helping prevent long-term damage and costly replacments.
